Tips for Self-Registration and organization data updates:

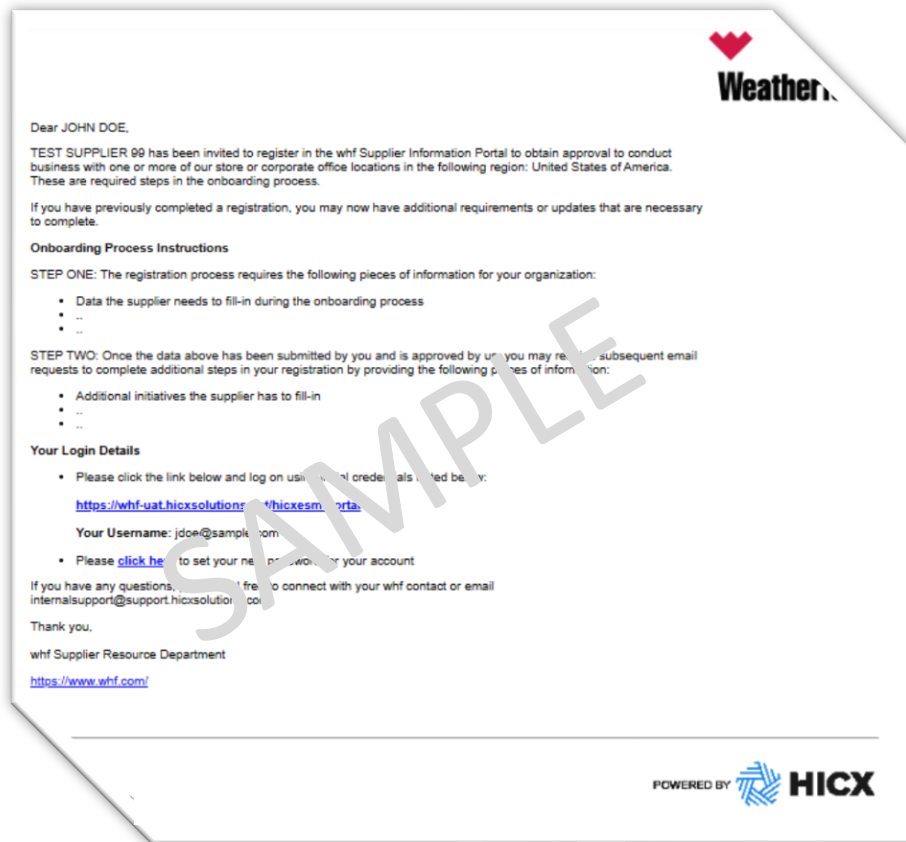
- ✓ Contacts added to your organization are pre-defined as administrators with full access to update relevant information including organization bank data. Please ensure you implement security around access from your users and that the additional functionalities to setup multi-factor authentication are completed.
- ✓ Please ensure you have handy information of your tax identification, date of incorporation and DUNS number.
- ✓ For input of bank data, you will be asked to upload two documents supporting this data: Company Letterhead and Bank Letterhead. For this latter, you can use a copy of a recent bank statement showing account owner information and bank data (you can mask balance and transaction details). You will be able to use the search functionality to locate your financial institution.
- ✓ Ensure that you set up your preferences, including the setting of a mobile device that will be used to authenticate your credentials. This is a security feature intended to add additional protection for any changes related to your bank information.
- ✓ You will be asked to upload copy of certificates, where applicable.





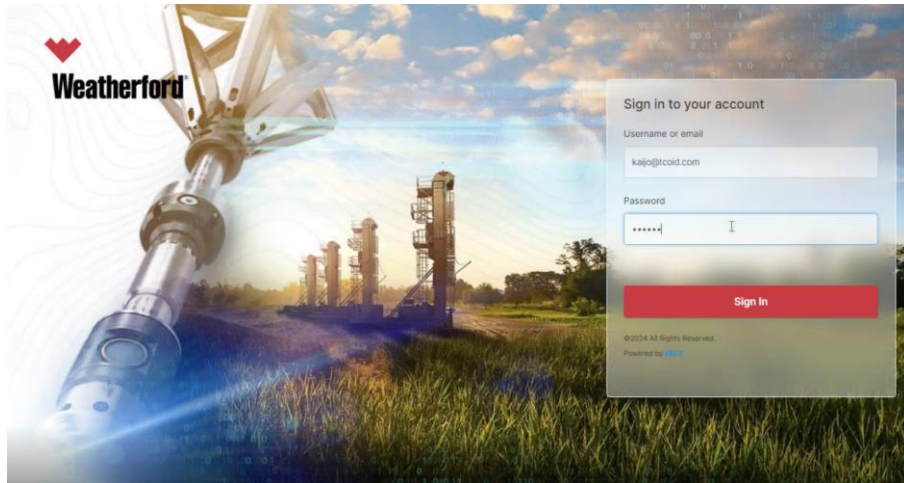
Weatherford Invitation:

- An email invitation will be sent to the primary contact for a supplier requesting them to register. The email will provide a link to the supplier portal as well as instructions on how to access it.
- A separate email notification will be sent for each questionnaire that you are asked to fill out as well.
- When clicking the link in the email you will be directed to the supplier portal login page. You may first be instructed to change your password and set up multi-factor authentication to enhance security around access.
- You will be able to define additional users and their profiles at a later stage.



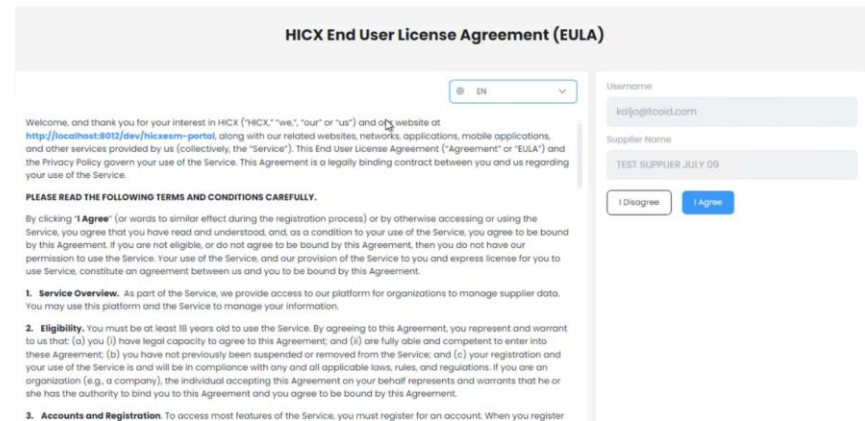

If no other contact exists, the request might need additional validations by Weatherford before the change can be implemented.

Weatherford International plc and its group companies (together "**Weatherford**") has a zero-tolerance approach to modern slavery in its supply chains.

'Freedom from slavery' is one of the most fundamental freedoms that applies to all people. Slavery refers to situations where a person's freedom or freedoms are taken away so that they can be exploited. Modern slavery may take many forms in which an individual is exploited by others, for personal or commercial gain. These may include (but are not limited to) human trafficking, forced or compulsory labor, child labor and debt bondage.

As slavery is a hidden crime and takes so many forms, we must all be vigilant in spotting the signs. Below are general definitions and examples of certain common forms of modern slavery, but these are not the exclusive forms such modern slavery might appear in; additionally not all such conditions must be present for an instance of human trafficking, forced or compulsory labor, child labor, or debt bondage to have occurred:

Human Trafficking

Definition: Human trafficking involves the recruitment, transportation, transfer, harboring, or receipt of a person for the purpose of exploitation.

Example: A worker was recruited from another country to work in your country as a cleaner. She works for 60 hours per week at less than minimum wage and lives in shared accommodation in abusive conditions. She is scared she will be deported or detained as she is not a regularized migrant. She cleans at a number of office blocks in the city center.

Forced or Compulsory Labor

Definition: Forced or Compulsory Labor is any work or services people are forced to do against their will, usually under threat of punishment.

Example: A person was forced to work for a family for more than 20 years in their construction business. He was paid less than 10% of the

Weatherford is required to comply with the laws and regulations of numerous countries that apply to its operations, including anti-money laundering and international trade laws enacted by E.U., Norway, U.K. and/ or U.S. authorities.

The EU, NO and UK have issued new restrictions related to iron and steel products (contained in chapters 72 and 73 of the UK and EU customs tariffs) that incorporate iron and steel products of Russian origin. Specifically:

The EU's eleventh package in Council Regulation (EU) 2023/1214 (June 23rd 2023) introduced a prohibition on the import or purchase of iron and steel products as listed in Annex XVII to the EU Russia Regulations when processed in a third country incorporating iron and steel product(s) originating in Russia as listed in Annex XVII.

Importers are required, at the point of importation, to provide evidence of the country of origin of the iron and steel inputs used for the processing of the product in the third country. Mill Test Certificates may be considered as sufficient evidence of the country of origin of the iron and steel inputs.

The Russia (Sanctions) (EU Exit) (Amendment) Regulations 2023 introduced a prohibition on the import of iron and steel products as listed in Schedule 3B to the UK Russia Regulations when processed in a third country incorporating iron and steel product(s) originating in Russia as listed in Schedule 3B.

Traders must have documentation available to demonstrate evidence of a good's supply chain to confirm that it is consistent with these sanctions. Mill Test Certificates may be considered as sufficient evidence of the country of origin of the iron and steel inputs.

To be certain that **Weatherford complies** with these sanctions, **our suppliers** must be aware of the requirements and confirm to us whether products to be supplied to Weatherford are affected by these restrictions.

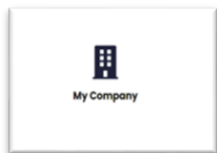

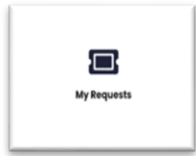
